#### Catalyst Program Description

Catalyst Newcastle is a university program comprising four humanities subjects which leading to the award of a **Certificate in Liberal Arts**. The second unit, 'Indigenous People' Past and Present' will be taught by Paul Gordon from Yarnteen Newcastle and will introduce students to historical and relevant issues, concepts and areas of change in Australia today.
