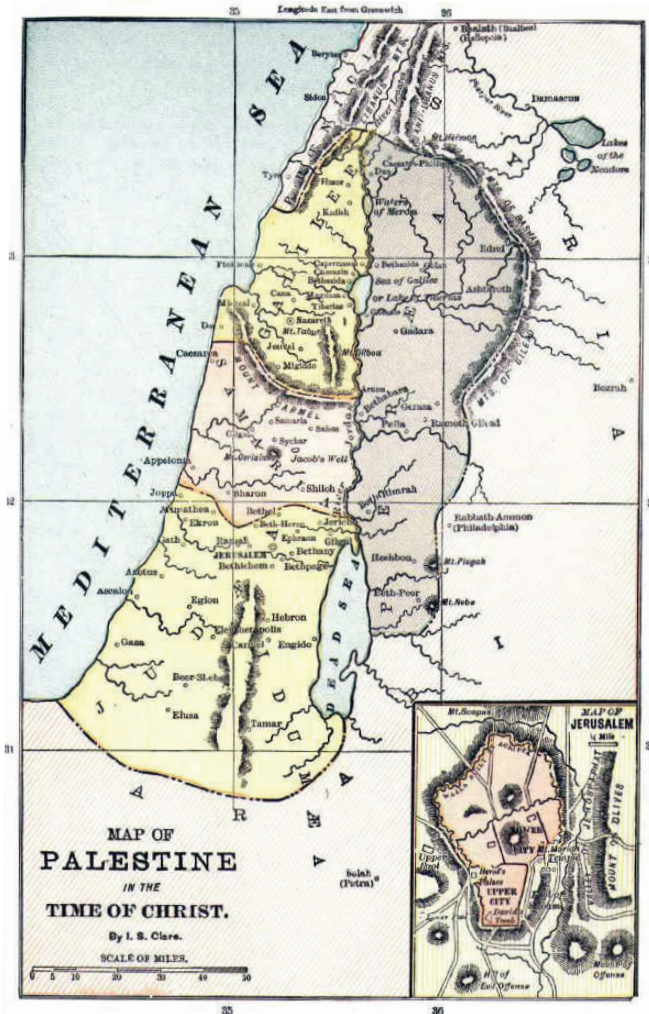

Unit 1.2

Moses, Mountains and Monuments
Exploring the Exodus experience as the Primal Narrative of the Chosen People.

Unit 1.3

"Of Cabbages and Kings..."
Savouring the varied flavours of Judah and Israel through the Books of Samuel and Kings.

Unit 1.4

"I have put my words in your mouth..."
Hearing the challenging voice of God who called the prophets.

Unit 1.5

"Hear, for I will speak noble things ..."
Singing the Songs of Zion and reflecting on the call of Wisdom.

Appreciating the needs of a second generation church with Matthew.
